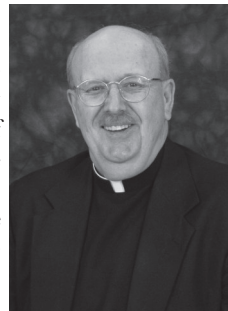
My Dear People:

How is your summer going? Are you outside of your homes a little more? I notice that many use the warmer weather to take care of some basic outside home maintenance. This past month, our parish home has been doing the same. We have now re-sealed and re-stripped the formerly cracked church and school parking lots. The badly weathered upper half of the western portion of the school and the chipped handrails also got a fresh coat of white paint. The damaged and overgrown portion of our chain link fence around the school playground/parking lot was cleaned up, repaired and partially replaced. We replaced much of the broken boundary around the playground equipment area with a new plastic boundary and some of its rotting timbers were replaced by a new cement retaining wall. Other playground equipment has been better
