Dear Parishioners:

More than an institution, the Church is more like a living, dynamic organism. It evolves and changes in its outward appearances while remaining essentially the same at its core. Over time, it adapts to each generation while maintaining timeless truths and teachings.



Pope Leo XIII established the Diocese of Sioux Falls in 1889 with Bishop Martin Marty as its first bishop. It encompasses all of South Dakota east of the Missouri River. While 180 parishes have opened and closed over the years, our diocese now has 150 parishes and 89 active priests; by 2016, we may have as few as 55 active priests. South Dakota's population is growing and is predicted to reach 847,000 by 2012. Our population is aging and shifting from rural areas into its cities. Within our cities, there are also demographic shifts in both age and population. The church must adapt to this.

The Diocese is committed to the goals of maintaining access to the sacraments, especially the Eucharist; solid faith formation; opportunities for vibrant and viable gatherings; and the physical and spiritual well-being of both its priests and all of its people;

Over the past year, the diocese has hired Teamworks to assist us in the process of gathering data to create a vision for 2014, the 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of our diocese. This vision will include practical and concrete applications by 2012. In part, the data includes demographics, households, priests, sacramental and parish activity and mass attendance.

You are invited to be part of the solution. Bishop Paul Swain asked a representative group of chancery staff and priests to join Teamworks to begin developing a vision. Their recommendations have been submitted and now a Lay Pastoral Planning Committee is providing consultation to the bishop regarding the vision. Members of this committee have already met in both the Redfield and Yankton areas. Members of the Sioux Falls area have already met at St. Michaels and St. Lamberts. Dan Wallgren is Christ the King's Lay Representative for the central Sioux Falls area and he is attending each of the twelve parish meetings in the central Sioux Falls area.

**The next meeting will be here at Christ The King on March 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. in the Community Center.** You are invited to attend this meeting and any future meetings at each of our Sioux Falls parishes. Parish representatives are seated up front

and will speak for the parishes. A question and answer period will be towards the end of these meetings which will allow anyone to ask questions and voice ideas or concerns. Please know that there is no final plan or vision at this time; we are engaged in the consultation phase.

We hope that you can join us and be part of the solution, the planning and the vision of our diocese.
