My Dear Parishioners:

May 1<sup>st</sup> is the Feast of Saint Joseph the Worker. It also marks the kick-off of the “Beacon of Hope” Campaign for our Cathedral of Saint Joseph. This weekend, Bishop Paul Swain will invite every household in the Diocese of Sioux Falls to be a part of the Preservation, Restoration and Beautification of our Mother Church of the diocese.



The name “cathedral” comes from the Greek & Latin word “cathedra” which means chair or throne. The sitting position is an ancient posture for teaching authority. Rabbis and Jesus, as well as early bishops and medieval theologians sat while teaching disciples.

Every diocese has one cathedral with one chair for its one bishop. The cathedral is recognized as the bishop’s official church by the Holy See in Rome. It is a visible link to the Pope and the universal Roman Catholic Church, and a visible link to each parish. These ecclesial links give the bishop the authority to teach, govern and sanctify the people of a diocese. It is vital part of our being one, holy, catholic and apostolic.

The cathedral is a central place of major diocesan liturgies, such as ordinations to bishop, priesthood and deaconate, synods, wedding anniversaries, chrisem mass and the rite of election for catechumens. While our diocesan cathedral is a place to pray, to go in need and to celebrate, it is also a cherished landmark of our city and a jewel of the state.



Ninety years ago, the bishop and the people of the diocese had a vision to build a cathedral based on the design of Emmanuel Masqueray. It was never fully completed, but now skilled artisans are restoring and completing its beauty. Falling into disrepair, we are taking measures to preserve it. The work is scheduled for completion next summer and it is projected to last for 100 years. From drainage tiles & tuck-pointing to roofing and gutters. From new electrical wiring & air conditioning to new lighting & paint. From a new bishop’s chair & altar to colorful plaster reliefs on walls & ceilings: It’s inspiring!

This is our time. This is our cathedral. As we preserve the legacy of faith of those who went before us, we restore and make beautiful a sign of hope for those yet unborn. Over a three-year pledge period, our parish hopes to raise \$90,000.00 towards our Beacon of Hope Campaign. All of our parish's contributions will go towards the preservation of the large Christ the King window which faces Minnesota avenue. Within a couple of weeks, each diocesan household will receive a letter and pledge card. We have this opportunity once in a lifetime. Please pray for the success of this effort.
